O'R TÎM ARDAL GWEINIDOGAETH FROM THE MINISTRY AREA TEAM

Ar ran Tîm Ardal Gweinidogaeth Bro Tysilio, dymunwn Pasg Hapus iawn i chwi oll! Yn ystod y Garawys, fe wnaethom ni ddilyn y cwrs Esgobaethol "Ewch felly a gwnewch disgyblion o'r holl genhedloedd", a ysbrydolodd drafodaethau am yr hyn y mae'n ei olygu i fod yn ddisgybl a sut yr ydym yn cyhoeddi Newyddion Da Iesu. Gallai hyn fod trwy ddweud wrth eraill, neu drwy weithredoedd o gariad a gwasanaeth tuag at eraill. Tra'n myfyrio ar sut mae pobl yn dod i ffydd, cofiais am eiriau Jane Williams yn ei llyfr *Lost for Words?*, sy'n dweud: 'Bydd yr hyn sy'n gwneud i bob un ohonom ddod i ffydd yng Nghrist a mynd ymlaen i gredu ac ymddiried yn ei fywyd newydd yn amrywio o berson i berson. Gellir dod o hyd i Iesu mewn sawl ffordd wahanol. Ein tasg, ar y Diwrnod Pasg hwn a bob amser, yw darganfod beth mae pobl ei angen er mwyn cwrdd â'r Crist atgyfodedig, a cheisio eu helpu yn yr angen hwnnw. Mae angen i rai gwrdd â Iesu mewn galar, rhai mewn gobai, rhai mewn cyffwrdd dynol, rhai mewn dadl resymegol, rhai mewn dicter ar greulondeb y byd. Mae Iesu am gwrdd â phawb lle gallant ddod o hyd iddo, fel y gall pawb rannu yn ei fywyd atgyfodedig. Nid oes cytundeb pecyn 'package deal', dim ond bywyd newydd. 'Bydded i'r Arglwydd Atgyfodedig gwrdd â phob un ohonoch ar eich pwynt o angen y Pasg hwn a bob amser.

On behalf of the Bro Tysilio Ministry Team, I wish you all a very Happy Easter! During Lent, we followed the Diocesan Course "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations", which inspired discussions about what it means to be a disciple and how we proclaim the Good News of Jesus. This might be by telling others, or through acts of love and service to others. As I reflected on how people come to faith, I remembered Jane Williams's words in her book Lost for Words? She wrote 'What makes each one of us come to faith in Christ and go on believing and trusting in his new life will vary from person to person. Jesus can be encountered in many different ways. Our task, on this Easter Day and always, is to discern what it is that people need in order to meet the risen Christ, and to try to help them in that need. Some need to meet Jesus in grief, some in hope, some in human touch, some in rational argument, some in anger at the cruelty of the world. Jesus wants to meet everyone where they can find him, so that all may share in his risen life. There isn't a package deal, only new life.' May the Risen Lord meet each one of you at your point of need this Easter and always.

Solidarity Symi - Andy Hawkins writes:

Very many warm thanks for all the fund raising efforts to support refugees in Symi and the Dodecanese. Your contributions will make a big difference. We will use the money to contribute to the relief parcels heading to the Aegean in May. Refugees are still arriving in the Dodecanese islands; on 17 March, 16 refugees including 4 children drowned when their boat capsized off the coast of Samos. The refugee camps are grim. This week, I am sending a magnificent parcel of trauma bears, blankets, cardigans, hats and booties from the wonderful knitters of Llys Menai and friends of Mary Price and Lisa Hughes to go to Symi in May.
